This year we will examine the vernacular buildings of market towns in Yorkshire. In addition one paper will look at the work and role of English Heritage in our understanding of these buildings and another will consider what the buildings tell us about the way people lived in the 18th century.

The venue is the Headingley campus of Leeds Metropolitan University. It is a few miles to the north-west of the city centre, easily accessible from the Leeds outer ring road (see map overleaf). There is plenty of parking on the campus. Tea, coffee and biscuits on arrival, an optional buffet-style sandwich lunch, and other refreshments at intervals through the day are all included.
